### CACTASMANIA COMPETITION RULES

For many growers that may not have entered a competition like this previously, we hope this will help you present your entry as the most appealing option to both the general public and the judges alike.

Firstly, there are many sections and sizes that apply both Cactus and Succulents, so irrespective if your plant/s is a miniature or a giant they are all suitable to enter.

More importantly, the following aspects apply TO ALL ENTRIES RECEIVED

The show committee will settle all disputes and their decisions will be final.

You must have owned the plant/s for at least THREE (3) MONTHS. Aspects the judges will take into account will include.

Condition of the plants size, rarity, plant and pot presentation.

Plants must be free of pests and diseases and have NO insecticide odour.

All plants must be labeled, to the best of the exhibitors ability,

HOWEVER there will be Marshalls available during the benching period to assist with this aspect.

## JUDGING POINTS WILL BE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS

Condition & Cultural Perfection 50 points
Degree of Maturity. 20 points
The rarity of plant. 10 points
The difficulty of culture. 5 points
Staging. 5 points



#### TOTAL POSSIBLE POINTS

BENCHING TIMES

Friday from 8am till 6pm UNLESS you contact the organizers for outside these times Saturday from 8am till 9.30am WITHOUT EXCEPTION as the room has to be prepared for opening at 10am sharp.

#### NOTE

This is the system used by various respectable societies world wide. We appreciate this may appear daunting, however do not be put off by the content. So bring along your prized possession/s and let it be seen and enjoyed by the crowds of patrons over the weekend.
